Swim Lessons Info

Our goal with the lessons program is to instruct children in water comfort and safety as well as stroke development. We strive to create a positive environment for the students to become confident in their swimming ability. The swim lesson program consists of 2-week sessions with ten classes offered Monday through Friday. The levels we offer are separated into Preschool classes for ages 3-6 and Youth classes for ages 7 and up. Fees **must** be paid at time of enrollment. If payment isn't made before the session, your child will not be permitted into the class.

Each child can miss one class per session. You must notify the office at least one day prior to the missed class in order to be refunded. Otherwise, you must pay for the class in which your child was absent.
