## School's Out Party

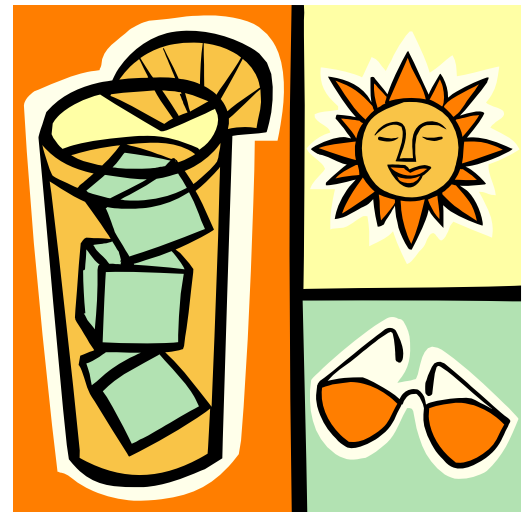

## Pool Rentals

Birthday? Team Party? Group Celebration? Rent the pool! You get the entire pool and pool house to yourself, and two to three lifeguards depending upon the size of your party. We will reserve the pool and/or shelter over the phone but require payment within 24 hours to hold the date. There is a \$25.00 deposit required to reserve the shelter. You can get the deposit back after the party if the area is clean and the garbage taken to the dumpster. Call the pool for availability. There are no pool rentals on June 16 or 17. There is a swim Meet on the 16th and the 17th is the school's out party.

## Swim Lessons

## Open to the Public

Registration for swim lessons begins **May 28** in person at the Pool House **during regular pool hours**. We provide swim lessons for ages three and older. This season we will offer five sessions. Sessions are 1/2 hour classes, five days a week for two weeks.

**Prices are per child**

**\$45 - Members**

**\$65 - Non Members**

Sign up at the pool office during regular pool hours. Payment is due upon signing up to hold your child's place in the class (cash or check only). No refunds for missed classes. Classes will be held at 10:00, 10:30; 11:00 and 11:30. Levels and classes will be determined by the demand. All instructors are WSI (Water Safety Instructor) trained. Private lessons are available.

---

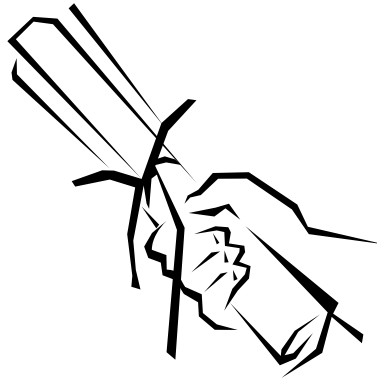
Mogos "Junior" Embaye will be graduating from Eastside Academy in Redmond. Junior hopes to attend Bellevue College next year to pursue further education.
