# Dophins Swim Team

Registration officially goes for a couple more weeks, but the team is very nearly full. There may be room for a couple more homeowners' kids in particular rosters that are not quite as fully packed. Look up the team website by searching for the "High Woodlands Dolphins," and click on the "Contact Us" link on the left side of the page to check with the team manager or registrar as to whether there are any openings left for your potential swimmer. But do it fast, because the remaining few spots will go fast.



Practice begins May 21<sup>st</sup> at the High Woodlands pool. Practice will be from 7:00 to 9:15 PM until school is out, and then 7:00 to 9:45 AM starting June 25.

**Caution:** When driving through the neighborhood, especially near the pool, please look out for kids walking to or from practice, and pay particular attention to your speed, and potential blind spots at corners and hills. The hill on 148<sup>th</sup> PL near the pool is an especially tricky area since you can't see much of the road in front of you in either direction until you've crested the hill.

## Swim Lessons

Registration for swim lessons begins **May 26, 2018** in person at the Pool House **during regular pool hours**.

Cost: Members \$50.00  
Guests of Members \$70.00

Sessions are 1/2 hour classes, five days a week, for two weeks.

Session #1 June 25 - July 6  
Session #2 July 9 - July 20  
Session #3 July 23 - August 3  
Session #4 August 6 - August 17

Ages 3 years and older

Payment is due when you sign up to hold your child's place in the class.

No refunds for missed classes.

Classes will be held at 10:00, 10:30, 11:00, & 11:30 am.

Levels and classes will be determined by the demand.

All teachers have been WSI (Water Safety Instructor) certified.

Private lessons are available

## Adult Swim

*Wednesdays 8:00 - 9:00 pm -- Begins June 27*

Must be at least 18 years old to participate. No Children on Deck. (Note: If no one has arrived by 8:15 pm the pool will close.)

Please review the rules before visiting the pool. It is the member's responsibility to ensure their guests know the rules when they visit.

Emergency Information forms need to be updated each year for every family using the pool.

## High Woodlands Homeowners Association Swimming Pool Rules and Regulations

1. All persons entering the pool must check in prior to entry.
2. All children age eight (8) and younger must be accompanied by a person at least twelve (12) years old considered competent by the pool management. Pool management reserves the right to restrict admittance of an unaccompanied child of any age.
3. No littering. You must clean up any spilled food or drink on pool deck.
4. No gum, food or drink allowed in pool.
5. No smoking or alcohol allowed on pool deck.
6. Any child in the wading pool must be accompanied by an adult at all times. Children above the age of five (5) are not allowed to use this area.
7. **All house guests of 48 hours duration or more will be treated as family members if the homeowner has notified the pool office at least one (1) day in advance.**
8. **A homeowner may bring up to three (3) guests at one time. More guests may be brought if the homeowner has received permission from the pool office prior to arrival. All guests must be accompanied at all times by the homeowner while at the pool. Only three (3) visits by the same guest are allowed each season. There is a \$2.00 daily fee for each guest. Grandchildren are not required to pay guest fees.**
9. Running or horseplay on the deck or in the bathhouse is not allowed.
10. All children ages twelve (12) and younger must pass the swim test before allowed in the deep end unless accompanied by an adult over the age of 18. The test first includes swimming one (1) length of the pool on the stomach without touching. The second part which must be done directly after the first includes treading water in the deep end for 30 seconds without stopping.

Whether the child passes is based on the discretion of lifeguard/pool management..

11. All persons must shower before entering the pool.
12. Conduct of disorderly nature, including abusive or profane language, vandalism, or which affects the enjoyment of the pool by others will not be permitted. First-time offenders will not be allowed in the pool temporarily (time at discretion of management). A second offense will result in a call to the parent(s). Third-time offenders will have pool privileges revoked from one day to the remainder of the season.
13. Any individual with an infectious disease, open sore, or wound can not use the pool. All band aids must be removed before entering the pool.
14. Advance arrangements for private parties during off-hours can be made with the pool office at least one (1) week prior to the event.
15. Only pool employees are allowed in the office and boiler room.
16. Floatation devices, snorkels and fins are permitted at the discretion of pool management.
17. No disposable diapers are allowed. All children not potty-trained must wear a swim diaper or similar protection and rubber pants. The office sells both.
18. The Association is not responsible for lost or stolen items. Leave valuables at home.
19. At the discretion of pool management, any individual not following the above rules will have his/her pool use suspended temporarily or for the remainder of the season. This also applies to swim team members.

## Pool Rentals

Birthday? Team Party? Group Celebration? Rent the pool! You get the entire pool and pool house to yourself, and two guards. A third guard may be required for a large group or young swimmers. There is an additional cost of \$35.00 per hour for the extra guard.

There are no pool rentals on Swim Meet dates.

Rentals can be reserved beginning **MAY 1st**. Reservations made before the pool opens must be made by calling the pool number 425-806-9119 and leaving a message. Calls will be answered in the order received starting on May 1 ...not before.

One hour: \$70

Two hours: \$140

(NO Monday - Thursday rental until school is out)

*June 23 - September 3:*

Weekdays 8:00pm to 10:00pm

We will reserve the pool and/or shelter over the phone but require payment within 24 hours to hold the date. There is a \$25.00 deposit required to reserve the shelter. You can get the deposit back after the party if the area is clean and the garbage taken to the dumpster.

## Home Owner's Dues Reminder

Your dues **MUST** be paid current (as of MAY 15th) in order to use the pool. If they are not current you will be referred to the treasurer. The pool staff will need to hear from the treasurer or manager personally before they will admit you.

If you are renting a house in High Woodlands and want to use the pool you will need to have your homeowner send a new email to the pool manager **each year** confirming you are the renter and the **names of people living in the house**.
