We provide swim lessons for ages three and older. This season we will offer four sessions. Sessions are 1/2 hour classes, five days a week for two weeks.

Prices are per child \$40 - Members \$60 - Non Members

Sign up at the pool office during regular pool hours.

Payment is due upon signing up to hold your child's place in the class. Classes will be held at 10:00, 10:30: 11:00 and 11:30. Levels and classes will be determined by the demand and will be assigned the Thursday before each session. Parents will be called the Friday before classes begin with times for their child. All instructors are WSI (Water Safety Instructor) trained. Private les-

sons are also available.

We are currently signing up for all sessions of swim lessons. However the deadline to secure a spot in any session is the Wednesday before the new session begins
