weeks.

Prices are per child  
\$40 - Members  
\$60 - Non Members

Sign up at the pool office  
during regular pool hours.

Payment is due upon signing  
up to hold your child's place  
in the class. Classes will be  
held at 10:00, 10:30; 11:00  
and 11:30. Levels and  
classes will be determined  
by the demand and will be  
assigned the Thursday be-  
fore each session. Parents  
will be called the Friday be-  
fore classes begin with times  
for their child. All instructors  
are WSI (Water Safety In-  
structor) trained. Private les-

sons are also available.

We are currently signing  
up for all sessions of  
swim lessons. However  
the deadline to secure a  
spot in any session is the  
Wednesday before the  
new session begins
